

Burnt Orange Woolly Bugger – by Mike



HOOK: Mustad 9674, size 8

THREAD: UTC 140, Burnt Orange

TAIL: Burnt Orange Marabou with strands of Silver, Copper, and Gold Flashabou

UNDERBODY: .020 Lead, 20 wraps, secured with thread and Zap-a-Gap

BODY: Medium Yellow/Orange variegated Chenille

RIB: 4lb. Stren monofilament

HACKLE: Natural Brown

HEAD: Thread and Sally Hanson Hard as Nails

NOTE: This version is tied “improved” style, with the rib tied in at tail, and the hackle tied in at head. The Hackle is palmered to the tail, and the rib is palmered to the head securing the hackle. This is the technique demonstrated by Nathan at the fly tying secession.
