### Two of Jim's Favourite Flies

# Bill's Yabbie,

- GAMAKATSU # 14 C12 H3S CURVED
- LEAD WIRE .15 4-5 TURNS
- BLACK THREAD
- BLACK SPARKLE DUB
- RED THREAD TO BUILD HEAD
- CLEAR HEAD CEMENT

#### Method:

- -tie in lead wire
- -tie in lead wire with thread
- -you can use red thread to tie the whole fly
- -tie in small tail
- -tie in copper wire
- -dub & spin combination dubbing
- -wind to eye of hook to form cigar shaped body (body should be about 4-5 mm thick)
- -now get a cock hackle and strip the barbules off one side
- -tie in and wind back to copper wire, the hackle will go all different directions
- -tie in hackle with copper wire 3-4 turns is enough
- -tie off wire and form a pronounced head
- -finish off with clear head cement

## Water Snail.

- GAMAKATSU # 14 L10-3H
- SHORT OLIVE / BLACK TURKEY MARABOU TAIL
- FINE COPPER WIRE
- LEAD WIRE (OPTIONAL, BEST TO HAVE BOTH)
- RUSTY BROWN COCK HACKLE
- SPUN MIX OLIVE POSSUM SPAKLE & DULL LIME DUBBING
- RED THREAD TO BUILD HEAD
- CLEAR HEAD CEMENT

#### Method:

- -tie in lead wire
- -tie in lead with black thread
- -dub & spin sparkle dub (fast tapered body)
- -tie off black thread
- -tie in red thread and form head
- -finish off with clear head cement

Now tie yourself a nice long 15-20 flouro carbon leader, tie the bill's yabbie on the point & the water snail on a dropper 500 mm up and start catching fish during the day!
