

Attention Upper Murrumbidgee Fishers: Tagged carp used for fish research



If caught, please RELEASE tagged fish and REPORT to the number on the tag for a REWARD. Take photos if possible. If deceased, please keep the fish.

31 carp have been tagged in the upper Murrumbidgee River (upstream of the ACT) so their movements can be tracked along the river system via our fish monitoring stations. Tagged carp are marked with a **long yellow tag** near their dorsal fin. These fish will lead us to carp breeding and aggregation sites, which are currently unknown for our catchment. This information will be used to better target carp control in the future. Carp removal trials are running in conjunction with this research.
