

# CAA Fly Tying – 22 June 2016

## Sakasa Kebari (Tenkara fly)



Item	Notes	Options
Hook	Dry Fly Hook Size 8-16	Curved shank wet fly TMC 2499sp-bl size 12-16
Thread	Cotton sewing thread	Black, Dark Brown, Cream olive etc.
Body	Thread	
Hackle	Hen hackle to match thread	Wooly bugger patch or oversized dry fly hackle
Thorax (optional)	Dubbing ball	Peacock herl, CDC or sparkle dub
Rib (optional)	Fine copper, various colours	Thread

Other Items		
Fly tying tools	Vice, bobbin, scissors etc	

Sakasa Kebari is a forward facing hackled fly originating from Japanese Tenkara Fishing. It is very simple, versatile and can be fished as a wet fly or in the surface film. They can be as simple as a thread body and soft hackle or you can add ribbing and a thorax just to be fancy.
