NSWCFA Interclub Fly Fishing Interclub Meet 2019

The Interclub Fly Fishing Meet will be held on the weekend before Mothers' Day, 3-5 May 2019 and based at Black Gold Motel, Wallerawang.

The Goal of the Interclub Meet is to maximise participation of **teams** (rather than individuals) from **Affiliates*** in friendly competition in various events related to **fly fishing**.

The Interclub Meet will focus on all the usual freshwater fish species targeted by fly fishers, including natives, trout, redfin and carp.

* Affiliates are clubs and associations that pay an annual subscription to the NSW Council of Freshwater Anglers.

Competitions. There are five competitions and 13 categories:

- Fly Fishing six categories for longest fish species: Impoundment Trout, Stream Trout, Bass, Other Native, Redfin and Carp;
- Fly Tying three categories: Open, Intermediate and Novice;
- Fly Casting Long distance accuracy;
- Fly Casting Short distance accuracy and
- Photography two categories: Open and Novice.

Team Points. Team Points of 7, 6, 5 and 4 points will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places respectively in each of the 13 categories.

Team Size. A team may comprise any number. However, the larger the team the greater chance of gaining places and acquiring team points.

Trophies. There are three perpetual trophies for the Interclub Meet.

- Largest Fish: "Otto's Fly Business, Inaugural Trophy Interclub Meet, Largest Fish Caught". Note that the 'largest fish' trophy is not necessarily for the largest trout.
- Best Flies Open Category : "Dan Engel Trophy".
- Best Club: "The World of Tackle, NSWCFA Interclub Meet, Club Teams Trophy".

Social Events and Prize Giving. The usual Friday night meet and greet and Saturday night BBQ will be held. On Saturday night the Fly Tying and Photography competition results will be announced and raffles will be run. On Sunday about midday the results of the Fishing and Casting competitions will be announced as will the best team and winner of the Club Teams Trophy.
