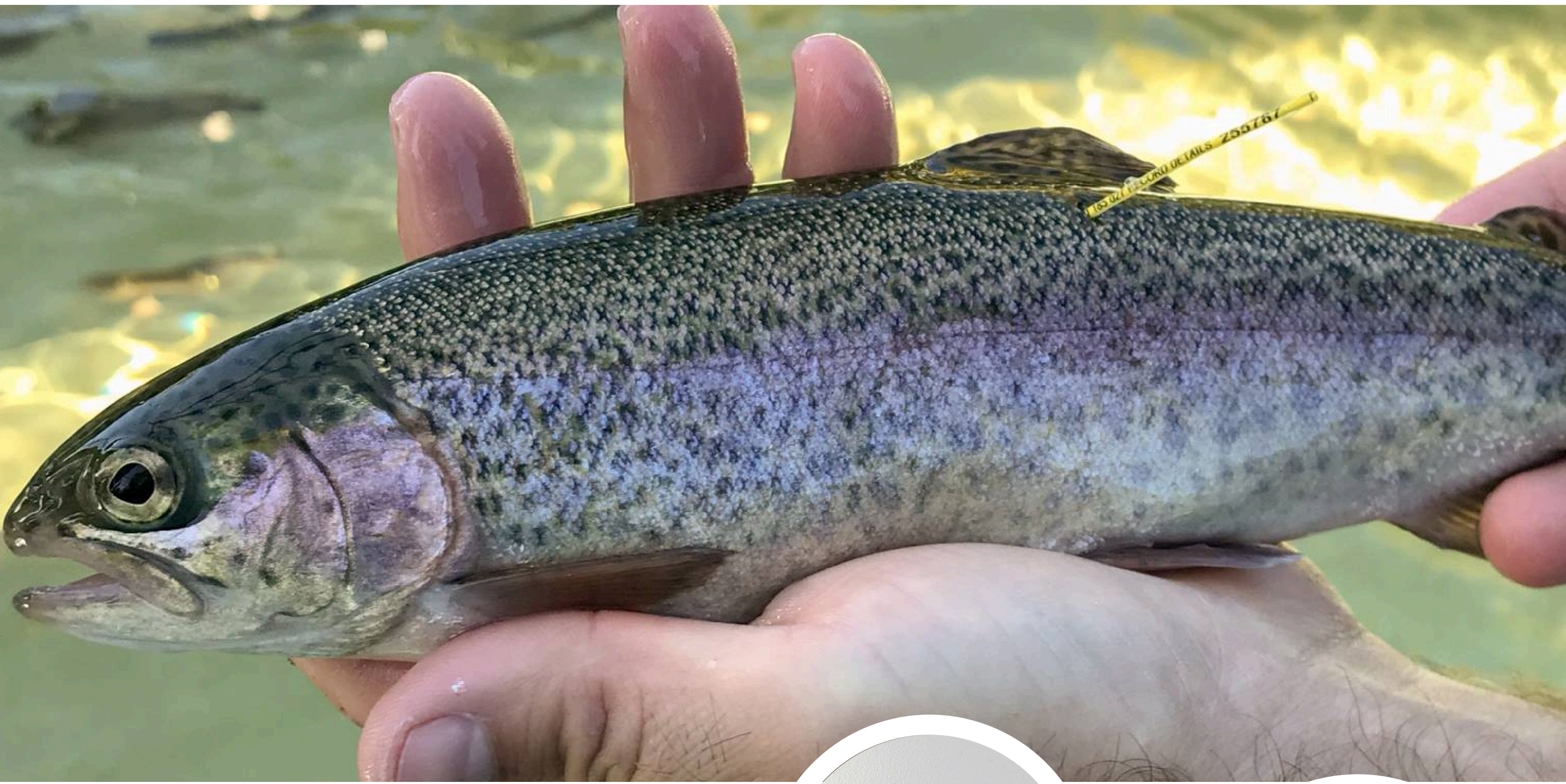




Reward for tagged rainbows
