## Meeting Point/Accommodation:

- Most of us will be camping at Wares Yards Campground. [-35.87658553138162, 148.61988632554218 [Google Link](#) ]. Refer to map. **Booking is strongly encouraged.** Book [online](#) or call the National Parks Contact Centre on 1300 072 757.
- Camping set-up and supplies to be organised by the individuals or your normal camping pals. All going well, we will be able to have a campfire, but be prepared to cook without campfires if fire bans are likely.
- Bring everything you need: camping / cooking gear, your own firewood (there may be some around), water and toilet paper, first aid kit, matches and warm clothing.
- **For Lyall.** Bring a winter...not summer sleeping bag 😊
- Adaminaby township (~30min) is closest supply and fuel point
- Other accommodation options are available in the local area

**Fishing Locations:** There are several great fishing spots within 30 minutes' drive of the campsite. You will need a vehicle to get to a fishing spot from the campsite. Google is your friend.

- Please contact me if you would like any tips for the trip.
- If you want to fish the creeks – practice your casting and accuracy for a range less than 15 meters!
- Please let me know if you want to be paired up with a more experienced fisher. I will make best efforts, but can't guarantee, to organise a 'hook-up' 😊
