On April 5-7 the Interclub competition will be held in Wallerawang. This year the Sydney Flyrodders club is organizing the event. The registration fee is \$50 per angler, this is a fund raiser for the important work of the Council of Freshwater Anglers. This is primarily done from the raffle prizes generously donated by affiliates. Our SFRC website has been modified to accommodate non-members and is running for registration for those wishing to attend.

The objectives of the Interclub are to promote freshwater fly and lure fishing and to promote the NSWCFA. Club teams will compete in fly and lure fishing and fly and plug casting events. Small prizes may be provided for placegetters in individual events, but the focus will be on competing for team points.

The team with most points will be awarded the 'best club team' trophy. The Teams Fishing competition will be centred at Wallerawang and in the lakes and streams in the surrounding area, but only where there is public access (ie. not through private land) and where fishing is permitted. Fish you could catch include:

- Trout
- Bass
- Redfin
- Carp
- Cod
- Yellowbelly

You can fish from the shore or from a boat/canoe/kayak. The DPI Angler Access site will give you plenty of options. Teams don't need to fish together but their combined score will enter for the placings.

As well as getting a chance to fish your registration will enable you to participate in a range of social activities including a lunch and brunch and provides an ideal opportunity to get to know anglers from all over the state.

We have reserved some accommodation with Black Gold Cabins in Wallerawang, and you can follow the links on the registration page to book your spot. Black Gold have other accommodation available, but you will need to book thru them. There is also free camping at Lake Wallace and plenty of Pub stays in the area.

Below is our outline of the event Club Teams competing in fly and lure fishing and casting to gain Team Points to win the 'Best Club Team' perpetual trophy with SFRC conducting the fly casting and the CCFR will conduct the plug casting. We would love to see you there.
